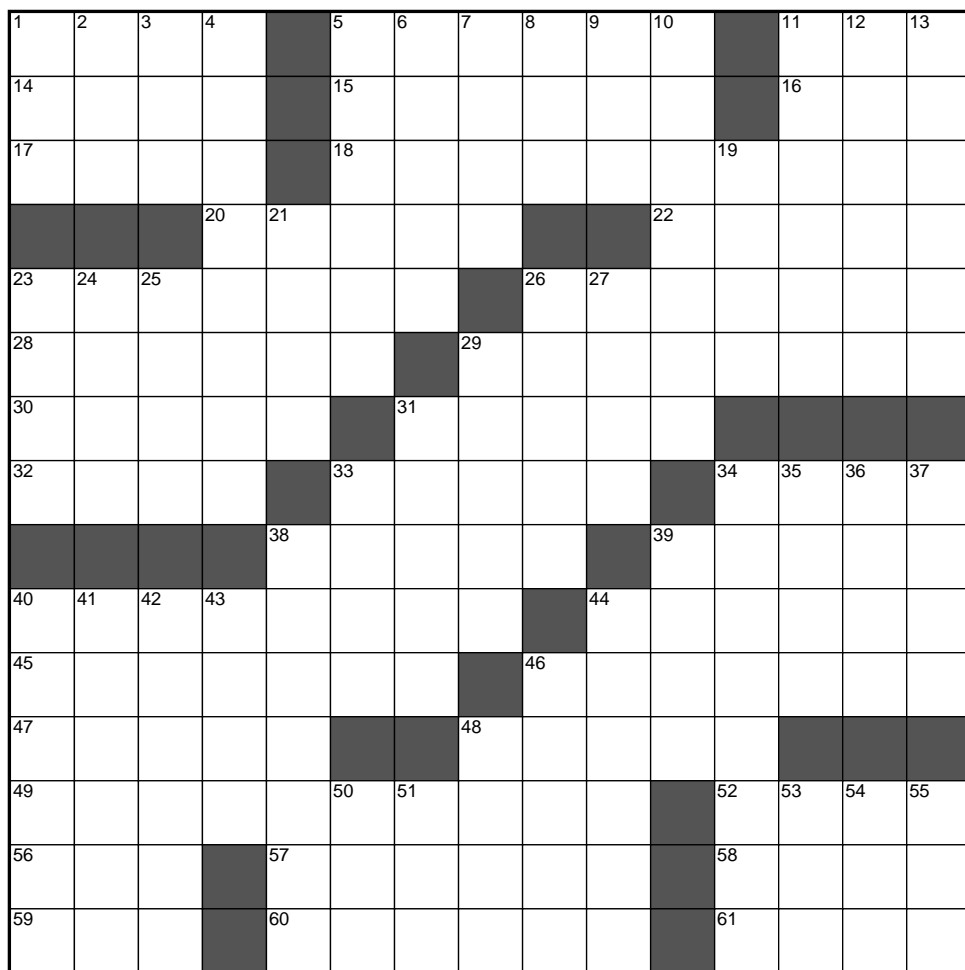


# Together Again
